All the children who have been School Councillors this year have been an absolute credit to themselves, the school and their classes. They began their journey by nominating themselves for the role of School Council, a daunting prospect for some children. After presenting to their classes and winning their role, they successfully began their journey. To signify the ending of the old School Council and the beginning of the new, we planted apple trees in the quiet area and on the school field.

Some of the things the children have done this year;

- Organising the Children in Need event in our school, successfully raising around £300
- Helping organise Sports Relief with the P.E coordinator
- After charity events, counting the money and informing whole school of amount raised
- Decorating our school for the Christmas celebrations
- Monitoring the cloakrooms, scoring on a daily basis
- Collecting pupil voice from their classes, awards for achievements i.e. attendance award
- Speaking to the PTA to about ways to improve our playground – providing pupil voice from the children in their classes to feedback
- Note taking during meetings to present information back to their classes – to ensure pupil voice is recorded
- Writing letters to parents regarding whole school charity events
- Addressing whole school notices during Collective Worship
- Speaking to classes about what qualities they are looking for in a Head Teacher
- Contributing to Head Teacher interviews – asking questions
- Planting apple trees in our school
- If the children in their classes have raised a concern or query, school councillors address this during meetings
- Organising a charity event to help raise money for past student Ella Baker
- Organising and hosting a thank you tea party for the volunteers in our school
