Year group	Activity	What to wear/bring...

Reception	Forest School – Helping Wildlife Through the Winter – Making Hedgehog homes in the forest. Making seed bombs to grow flowers for when the bees come out of hibernation.	Clothes in a bag suitable for Forest School.
Year 1	The Macs Farm have asked the children to design posters about being respectful of nature farms and the countryside. They are also donating eggs so we would like the children to bake cakes to sell to raise money for The Macs Farm.
