Listen carefully

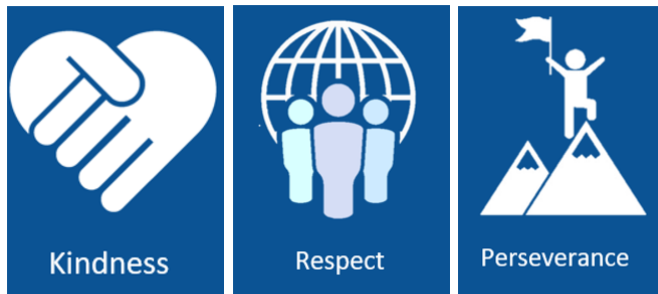
Be polite
